Method 5: Eco market

Examples of ideas and materials for making eco-products

Reusable cardboard bag

Materials:

- Recycled cardboard
- Glue or tape
- Rope or recycled fabric materials for handles
- Paints, markers, stickers for decoration

Instructions:

- Cut the cardboard into a rectangle for the body of the bag.
- Glue the sides to form a bag.
- Drill holes at the top and thread the rope through for the handles.
- Decorate the bag with drawings, messages or patterns that promote ecology

Recycled pencil organizer

Materials:

- Cardboard box of cereal or paper towels
- Glue or scissors
- Recycled paper, old magazines or fabric for decoration
- Markers or stickers

Instructions:

- Clean and cut the box to the desired height.
- Line the outer part with decorative paper or fabric.
- Divide the interior into compartments using pieces of cardboard.
- Add decorations like drawings or motivational messages.

Cardboard picture frame

Materials:

- Packaging cardboard
- Glue or tape
- Scissors or cutter
- Decorative paper, magazines, fabric for decoration
- Old CD for great details (optional)

Instructions:

- Cut two pieces of cardboard in the shape of a frame.
- Glue the decorative paper to the front.
- At the back, add a stand made of a piece of cardboard.
- Insert a photo or drawing and attach the back side.

T-shirt bag

Materials:

- An old t-shirt (preferably thicker for greater durability)
- Scissors
- Textile markers or chalk for marking

Instructions:

- Cut the sleeves and make a larger opening around the collar. These are the handles and the main opening of the bag.
- On the lower part of the T-shirt, cut fringes 10 cm long at intervals of 2-3 cm.
- Tie the opposite tassels into knots to close the bottom of the bag.
- Decorate the bag with textile markers.
